Fruity, Lighter-bodied White Wines

Estancia, Pinot Grigio, California 32.00

Tart with citrusy acidity and flavors of just slightly sweetened lemon juice.

Erath Pinot Gris, Oregon 32.00

Tropical fruit, lemon and floral notes seamlessly balanced with a clean lift of acidity.

“J”, Pinot Gris, Sonoma, California 42.00

Substantial structure brightened by flavors of pear and Pippin apples with a delicate fresh finish. The New World version of Pinot Grigio.

Sterling Organic Sauvignon Blanc, Mendocino, California 28.00

Bright, mouth filling medley of ruby grapefruit, lemon lime and tropical notes of guava, papaya, and passion fruit.

Chateau Ste. Michelle Horse Heaven Sauvignon Blanc, Washington 32.00

Open-textured and appealing for the way it plays its orange peel and grapefruit flavors against lively acidity without feeling sharp.

Charles Krug Sauvignon Blanc, Napa, California 36.00

Fruit forward tropical notes of banana, pineapple and accents of lemon-lime. Pear nectar nuances and hints of peach skin ensure a smooth, balanced finish.

Ferrari-Carano, Fume Blanc, California 38.00

Zesty flavors and aromas of grapefruit, citrus and honeydew mingle with a subtle grassy note that is complemented by a lingering finish of mango and guava.

Kim Crawford, Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 46.00

Fragrant and complex, with a refreshing burst of lime, guava, grapefruit and grass flavors.

Jolivet, Sancerre, Loire Valley, France 45.00

This racy, seductive Sauvignon Blanc is a classic match with pasta, seafood or vegetarian dishes.

Valley of the Moon, Pinot Blanc, California 32.00

Lovely floral aromas followed by bright fruit and a refreshing finish. One of our favorites with chicken or seafood.

Rosenblum Kathy's Cuvee, Viognier California 38.00

Beautiful aromas & flavors of honeyed apricots, peaches, vanilla, with subtle hints of tropical fruit and a touch of toasted oak.

Jade White Blend, California 38.00

An amazing white blend of Chardonnay, Marsanne, Pinot Gris, Riesling, Malvasia Bianca, Sauvignon Blanc and Viognier. Boasting flavors of lemon curd, crisp green apple and other orchard fruits laced with light caramel and butter toffee notes. The finish is crisp and clean.

Eroica, Riesling, Washington 44.00

White peach and fresh apricot aromas characteristic of Washington State Rieslings, melded with the mineral, floral notes and lively acidity associated with German Rieslings.



Medium/Full-Bodied Red Varietals

Bridlewood, Pinot Noir, California 30.00

Sweet cherry and tangy current notes lead the palate to flavors of berries, pomegranates and mushrooms. Smoky oak and spice combine with elegant tannins to stretch the mid palate, ending in a luscious finish.

Wild Horse Pinot Noir, Paso Robles, California 40.00

Aromas and flavors of fresh strawberries, forest floor, and hints of vanilla from the oak aging. With a lush mouth feel and enticing acidity.

Domaine Chandon, Pinot Noir, California 48.00

Rich and supple on the palate, this wine exhibits wonderful brightness of fruit.

Clos LaChance Pinot Noir, Santa Cruz, California 58.00

A glass of silk, flavored with cherries, dried strawberries, cola, and a bit of suede. The oak aging contributes to sweet tannins and adding a touch of vanilla.

Terra Noble Reserva Carmenere, Chile 32.00

Rich, dark black fruit and a touch of spiciness from oak aging.

Wyndham Shiraz Bin 555, Australia 28.00

This medium-bodied Shiraz offers bright fruit-forward flavors of plums and strawberry, followed by a dash of pepper and a touch of black licorice.

Razor's Edge, Shiraz, Australia 34.00

Nice texture with sweet chocolate berries in the mouth. Dark cherry flavors, a big, all-around wine.

Rosenblum, Petite Sirah, California 38.00

Rich full flavors of ripe blackberries, plums and chocolate, with a hint of black pepper, violets and spice.

B&G, Chateaufeuf du Pape, Rhone, France 44.00

A classic wine for lamb or beef from a consistently reliable producer. Earthy, spicy, jammy flavors with a persistent finish.

Santa Cristina, Toscana, Tuscany, Italy 28.00

Fruity, crisp and fresh. Well structured and harmonious on the palate, with soft, sweet tannins.

Zenato, Valpolicella Classico, Veneto, Italy 34.00

The predominate Corvina grape style invites the blackberry jam flavors with a hint of clove spice for a velvety soft finish.

Ruffino, Gold Chianti Classico Riserva, Tuscany, Italy 68.00

The King of Chianti. The balance of soft red fruit and light oak make this easy drinking wine a perfect pairing for most foods.

Allegrini Palazzo Delle Torre, Veneto, Italy 48.00

Intense, herb-infused, black cherry fruit interwoven with notes of white chocolate, mocha and almonds.

Valley of the Moon, Zinfandel, California 34.00

Supple and pure with sweet raspberry and cherry flavors dusted with crushed spice and finished with soft friendly tannins.

Renwood, Zinfandel "Old Vines," Amador County, California 44.00

The average age of the vines is 30 years for this zesty red. Concentrated blackberry, raspberry flavors with an earthy finish.

Navarro Correias Malbec Privada, Argentina 30.00

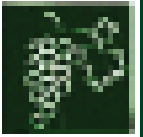
Flavors of ripe plums, cherries and raspberries that combine to magnificent effect in this generous, full-bodied wine. Well-defined tannins yield to a long, soft, memorable finish.

Christine Andrews Malbec, Lodi, California 38.00

Think of ripe, red cherries, plums and luscious currants. The flavors complement the nose with rich, ripe fruit overlapped by spicy cherry and hints of sweet oak. Medium bodied with mature tannins.

Campo Viejo Gran Reserva Rioja, Spain 38.00

Vanilla, cinnamon and cloves lead to a smooth, oaky, rounded, lingering, velvety finish.



Medium/Full-bodied Merlot, Cabernet and Meritage

14 Hands, Merlot, Washington 28.00

Flavors of blackberry and spice are enhanced by a splash of Cabernet Sauvignon for structure and complexity.

Franciscan, Oakville Merlot, Napa, California 42.00

Merlot for serious wine lovers. Great depth and structure with a very smooth finish. Delightful with tenderloin.

Ferrari-Carano, Merlot, Sonoma, California 54.00

Elegant and full-bodied, rich, concentrated fruit with supple, well-rounded tannins. French oak aging adds a hint of cedar and spice to the wine's intense black cherry and plum.

Sterling, Vintner's Collection Cabernet Sauvignon, North Coast, California 34.00

Flavors are of blackberry and other dark fruit, black olives, caramel, root beer and vanilla. Round and chewy tannins, offering great balance and a lingering toasty and fruity finish.

Casa Lapostolle, Cuvée Alexandre Cabernet Sauvignon, Rapel, Chile 36.00

*This delicious wine just scored big with *The Wine Spectator*. Abundant forward fruit that invites earthy overtones and a balanced tannic finish. A wonderful selection for red meat dishes.*

Newton, Claret, Napa, California 40.00

On the palate ripe tannins surround rich black cherries, blackberries and plum flavors with a hint of toasted oak balanced with a nice acidity.

Chateau Greysac, Bordeaux France 42.00

Hints of sweet cherries, figs, plums, and smoky licorice along with supple tannin, a beautiful texture, medium body, and no hard edges.

Simi, Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, California 46.00

Wild berries, ripe plums and sweet oak mingle with approachable, forward tannins in our richly styled Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon.

Beaulieu Vineyard, Rutherford Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California 50.00

The benchmark of all California Cabernet. Always great, always a value.

Turnbull, Old Bull, Napa, California 52.00

Blend: 70% Merlot, 11% Tempranillo, 7% Petite Sirah, 5% Syrah, 4% Sangiovese, 3% Barbera. Rich with aromas of plums, berries, dried cherries and a touch of mocha—in the glass the dense dark flavors of blackberry and cocoa dominate.

Estancia Meritage, California 54.00

Rich and bold with intense flavors of chocolate dipped black fruit, accompanied by notes of sweet oak. Wonderfully structured ripe tannins lead to a nice long, fruit driven finish.

Chimney Rock, Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve, Napa, California 115.00

Complex with layers of black cherry, currant, toasty oak and spice. An impressive wine that is layered and completely balanced.

Turnbull Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California 95.00

Dark rich and extracted this wine has aromas of cassis, black cherry and currants. Balanced oak nuances add both a 'sweetness' and roundness to this aromatic and powerful wine.

Ferrari-Carano Tresor, Sonoma California 105.00

A classic Bordeaux Blend--Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Merlot, Petit Verdot, and Cabernet Franc. Delicious aromas of Bing cherries, blueberry preserves and an herbal, black tea leaf nuance combine with an elegant mid-palate of fresh-picked berry and roasted mocha notes. With a full bodied and richly-textured tannin profile, this wine's upfront silkiness and roundness

Flora Springs Trilogy, Napa, California 130.00

Cabernet flavors of black cherry, cassis and tea, accented by hints of raspberry from the Merlot, tobacco from the Cabernet Franc, plum from the Petit Verdot and a ruby richness from the Malbec.

Chateau Ste. Michelle, Col Solare, Cabernet Sauvignon, Washington 120.00

Rich and balanced on the palate, this wine finishes with long, lingering flavors of cocoa, black currant, and vanilla.

Rubicon Estate, Cask Cabernet, Napa, California 150.00

Loaded with ripe red cherry and rum raisin scents, with dense and supple tannins. Wine Enthusiast awards a 95 point score.

Antinori Tignanello Toscana Tuscany, Italy 145.00

One of the first "Super Tuscans," Tignanello is meant to last. Deeply expressive, it reveals black cherries, licorice, tar and sweet toasted oak on a linear, silky-textured frame of great class and elegance, showing outstanding presence on the palate and fine tannins to round out the finish.

Zenato, Amarone, Veneto, Italy 125.00

This is a ruby red wine with deep, smokey, dried fruit aromas. The wine is very rich in fruit on the palate and very long lasting.



Medium / Full-bodied Chardonnays

Clos du Bois, Chardonnay, California 30.00

Soft, rich and full of vanilla and ripe golden delicious apple flavors with a multilayered finish with notes of toasted almonds, caramel and butter.

Villa Maria unoaked Chardonnay, New Zealand 34.00

Full of ripe peach and stone-fruit flavors this wine is finely balanced with an edge of minerality.

Edna Valley, Chardonnay, California 36.00

Delicious oak with smoky vanilla and butter cream flavors that blend with the lush white peach, sweet spice, followed by a subtle mineral component.

Robert Vocoret, Chablis, Burgundy, France 38.00

Full-bodied and elegant. Crisp, lively and complex mineral and herb flavors with a light oak finish.

Casa Lapostolle, Cuvee Alexandre, Chardonnay, Chile 38.00

Subtle elegance and a surprising freshness at the attack that develops into a round and juicy mid palate. Finish is long and intense.

Franciscan, Napa Chardonnay, California 38.00

Ripe apple flavors followed by a welcome hint of vanilla and a soft buttery finish.

JJ Vincent, Pouilly-Fuisse, Macon, France 42.00

Crisp, chalky flavors of apple and butter. A stylish and elegant styled chardonnay. A great match for fish, shellfish or chicken.

Steele, Cuvee Chardonnay, California 46.00

Amazing winemaker, Jed Steele, crafts a sleek, full and polished wine with pretty citrus, toasty oak and nectarine flavors.

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars, Karia Chardonnay, Napa, California 65.00

Subtle oak and clean, restrained Chardonnay fruit reminiscent of cream, apple, pear and citrus, subtle minerality; balanced, elegant, full of finesse.

Chalone, Pinnacles Chardonnay, California 68.00

Big in citrusy acids and dusty tannins with a sunburst of spiced peach and papaya flavor.





Managers' Featured Reserve Wines

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars, Napa California

"A Napa Valley First Growth" Founded by Warren Winiarski and his family in 1970.

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars is best known for our estate-grown Cabernet Sauvignons—CASK 23, S.L.V., and FAY. Over the years, these wines have become some of the most highly regarded and collected wines worldwide. They are fashioned to express classic elegance, structure, and ageability, and to reflect the place in which they are grown. The 1976 Paris tasting, or Judgment of Paris as it became known, had a revolutionary effect, "like a vinous shot heard round the world." – Barbara Ensrud, Wall Street Journal. The unthinkable happened. The 1973 Stag's Leap Wine Cellars S.L.V. Cabernet Sauvignon – the first vintage produced with grapes from vines a mere three years old – was judged the best. The Cabernet had bested four top-ranked Bordeaux, including first-growths Château Mouton-Rothschild and Château Haut-Brion. The 1973 Chateau Montelena Chardonnay from California bested its French counterparts.

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Karia 65.00

Subtle oak and clean restrained Chardonnay fruit reminiscent of cream, apple, pear, citrus and subtle minerality; balanced, elegant and full of finesse.

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Merlot 88.00

This wine is wonderfully aromatic with intense fruit notes of cherry, pomegranate, plum and strawberry, laced with spicy accents of vanilla, white pepper, and cinnamon. The aromas carry over to the palate, with an additional touch of milk chocolate. Subtle tannins gently grip the palate of this gracefully structured wine.

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Artemis Cabernet Sauvignon 105.00

Small amounts of Merlot and Petit Verdot were blended with the Cabernet Sauvignon for another layer of complexity to the raspberry, red currant, orange peel, cocoa powder and ginger contribute to the fine grained tannins and balanced acidity that invite a rich complete mouthfeel.

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars "Fay" Cabernet Sauvignon 180.00

FAY shows the typical bright cherry aromatic signature of the vineyard, as well as barrel spice, sandalwood, red plum and subtle sous bois (forest floor) aromas. The palate is fresh and energetic, with perfectly ripened red and black cherry and plum fruit. Gentle notes of spice, caramel and marshmallow cream sit in the background, adding nuance without masking the fruit character

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars SLV 225.00

The dark fruit tones of blackberry and black plum are typical of the vineyard, as well as notes of cassis, bramble, Chinese five-spice, caramel and vanilla. There is an elegant mineral quality on the nose and lingering finish that invite silken tannins.

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars "Cask 23" 295.00

CASK 23 is liquid art. It's the most beautiful painting we can create from the lines, colors and shadings we're given each vintage by the grapes from our S.L.V. and FAY estate vineyards. Named for the large wood cask in which the first vintage (1974) of this wine was aged, CASK 23 is not only the finest and most site-expressive wine we produce, it's a benchmark for California Cabernet Sauvignon.
